First National Bank of Floydada's 2019 Punkin Days BBO Cook-off Rules

- 1. All teams must submit an entry form and the entry fee to compete. Each meat class is \$25.
- 2. Entry forms may be obtained by emailing manager@floydadachamber.com
- 3. Entry forms must be received by October 11, 2019. No exceptions.
- 4. Eachteamwillprovidetheirownequipmentandsupplies including a grill/cooker and cooking equipment.
- 5. Eachteamwillbringtheir own products, including raw, unseasoned meat and seasonings.
- 6. Each team will receive a designated space to cook under a permanent metal awning.
- 7. All marinating, seasoning, and cooking of the product shall be done within the confines of the team's assigned cooking space. No seasoning, marinating or cooking of any kind may begin before 7:30 pm, Friday, October 11th.
- 8. Contestants must adhere to all electrical, fire, health and other codes.
- 9. All contestants are expected to respect the rights of other teams. Profane language or infringement on another team's area will not be permitted.
- 10. All cook of fareas must be cleaned and vacated by 7 pm on Saturday October 12th, 2019.

Set Up-Underneath car awning located at the intersection of Main and Mississippi Streets.

- 1. Vehicles or trailers will be allowed in the designated cooking area <u>-but not both</u>. Tents allowed within cooking area. Campers/RVs will be accommodated NEAR the cooking area (Within the same city block). No hook-ups will be available.
- 2. Electricity will be provided at cook-sites. 100 ft. electrical cords will be allowed, but not provided by organizers.

Pit Teams & Pits

- 1. Maximum of four (4) members per team. No minimum.
- 2. Pit will be any commercial or homemade, trailered or un-trailered pit or smoker, may include gas or electricity for use to start natural fiber (wood) substance only.
- 3. All fires for cooking meat must be wood or wood products (charcoal), or wood pellets. No gas or electric cooking heat.

Turn-in Quantities—9 X 9 containers, with foil will be provided to Cooks

- 1. Brisket: Cooks will turn in seven (7) full slices, approximately 1/4 to 3/8 inch thick slices, with the ends of the brisket. If sliced too thick or too thin, the cook will be required to correct the entry.
- 2. Pork Spare Ribs: Cook will turn in seven (7) pork spare ribs.

3. Chicken: Cooks will turn in one half of a whole chicken not dis-jointed containing skin, breast portion, leg, thigh and wing. (Wing tip is optional.)

Garnishes

- 1. Cooking with sauces is allowed, however, when preparing meat for turn-in, nothing may be added to the meat in the tray. Nothing should be puddled in turn-in container.
- 2. Any and all garnishes are prohibited.

<u>Time Line – Friday, October 11, 2019</u>

5:00 pm –set up begins. You may drive up close to the cooking area, unload then remove your vehicle. 6:00 pm – team check in – all meat must be raw and uncooked at check-in and presented for inspection in original packing from the store.

6:30 pm -cooking can begin

Time Line – Saturday, October 12, 2019

2:00pm-judging turn-in time. Meat classes will be turned in on a staggered schedule.

3:30 pm- Winners announced under pavilion.

Judging

- 1. Identical judging containers will be handed out. Nothing but the meat can be in the container when it is presented for judging.
- 2. Entries will be judged by a team of three (3) judges.
- 3. The decision of the judges is final.
- 4. Youarewelcometohandoutsamples; however, youare not allowed to accept any kind of payment for them.
